Checklist for drafting posts:

- 1. ensure the word length 500 1400 words;
- start the post with a sentence summarizing the main message of the text;
- 3. refer to a recent development at the beginning of the text;
- 4. make sure to clarify how the text is connected with dispute resolution involving CIS parties;
- 5. avoid long lists and quotations. Paraphrase instead;
- 6. insert web links where appropriate. Attach files with the court judgments you invoke in the text;
- 7. avoid numerous numbers and complicated phrases. Limit the length of each sentence to 3 lines;
- 8. keep paragraph length not more than 8 lines;
- 9. replace Passive Voice with Active Voice where possible;
- 10. replace the forms of the verb 'to be' with stronger verbs such as 'to become, to remain';
- 11. ensure the balance between facts and legal analysis;
- 12. make subtitles throughout the text (if possible they should be selfexplanatory);
- 13. choose and attach an appropriate picture (in JPEG);
- 14. make a list of keywords;
- 15. if you are new at CIS Arbitration Forum, add a few words about yourself.
